



<ul style="list-style-type: none"> She immigrated in 1882 to Porter County, Indiana. 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> She had a residence before 1890 in Burdick, Porter County, Indiana. George and Lavica probably lived here before moving to Valparaiso. In a letter from Howard Field to Marjorie Field Holt, he states, "When we were young we would go to Burdick (east of Chesterton) every fall to get walnuts and hickory nuts. I always had an impression that at some time the George Field tribe had lived there. When we would go, Dad always spoke of it as home, perhaps the house had burned, as there was none there." 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> She resided at 11 La Porte Ave. in Valparaiso, Porter County, Indiana in 1893. 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> She resided at 9 La Porte Ave. in Valparaiso, Porter County, Indiana between 1890 and 1893. 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> She resided at Jefferson St. in Valparaiso, Porter County, Indiana. The date of this residence is unknwn. It would have been prior to his living at 1001 Oak St. 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> She resided at 69 Oak St. in Valparaiso, Porter County, Indiana from 1898 to 1902. 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1900 Census: wife in the household of George Feilds, 42, born, Aug 1857, Ohio, married 20 years, 6 children, 6 living, 1900, Center Twp., Porter County, Indiana. 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> She resided at 1001 East Oak Street, Valparaiso, Porter County, Indiana in Valparaiso, Porter County, Indiana from about 1905 to 1915. George and Lavica bought this property on 5 April 1898. This house is next door to John and Jenny Hinkle's house (Lavica Hinkle's brother) and the two houses are mirror images of each other. According to to a letter from his granddaughter Kathryn Field Runnion, George built this house: "Marge [another granddaughter, Marjorie Field Holt] knew of two more residences of George E. and Lavica probably before he built." Presumably the Hinkles also built thier house at the same time. George was a carpenter until 1905 and was also listed as a builder and contractor in the 1902 city directory. It is highly likely that he was building both his own home and the Hinkle house at this time.

General:

According to the 1880 Federal Census for White River Township, Gibson Couty, Indiana, Lavica was living in John Steelman's household, where she was listed as a cousin. John's wife, Phebe Elizabeth Hinkle, was the sister of Lavica's father Samuel. Seven months later she married George E. Field, becoming his second wife.

Fall Down Stairs Fatal

Mrs. George Field, on east Oak St. accidentally fell down the cellar stairway at her home about 6 o'clock last evening and sustained injuries which caused her death at 3 o'clock this morning.

The funeral services will be held from the home Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. Carpenter officiating, with interment following in the Maplewood cemetery.

Deceased was born in Springfield, Ohio, and was the daughter of Samuel and Nancy Hinkle. Eight children were born in her family, all being dead except one sister, Margaret Canster, of Long Lane, Mo. She was married in 1880 to George E. Field and has lived in Valparaiso since 1882. Six children were born to this union, Clarence, Walter, Harvey and Nelson, of this city, Elmer of Chicago. The only daughter, Mary, died when 8 years of age. Mr. Field, the husband, died 7 years ago. She was a life long member of the Methodist church and was beloved by a large circle of friends.

When the accident, which caused her death, occurred, she had gone to get some butter for the evening meal and had a plate and knife in her hand, but stepped into an open cellar door, falling to the concrete floor below. No bones were broken, but she was picked up unconscious and never rallied from the effects of the fall sufficient to regain consciousness.
