

This chart comes from a hand written list of No. 1 Class book from the Methodist Episcopal Church which was held in the Steelman Chapel. We are not sure where the original document is. It is possibly in the genealogy collection of the Princeton Public Library of Princeton, Indiana.

it is dated A. D. 1851. The names in this chart have in some cases been annotated to show who they actually are. The right column has been added to show relationship to George and Lavica Hinkle Field or to other members just for interest. Many of these people owned and farmed land around the chapel. In 1968 the Steelman Chapel was in good condition. By 1999, it was beginning to slide off its foundation and it was finally demolished in 1999, and a small monument was erected in its memory. It was built in 1853. It was very sad to see this bit of Gibson County, Indiana demolished.
